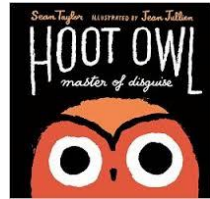

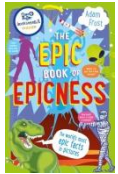
Welcome to another issue of '*Reading Rockets*'; a newsletter created by the Reading Ambassadors with news about their projects and your library.
