## ENGLISH (LINK TO PROJECT)

### Myths –

Entertaining narrative based on Greek myths. As we progress through this unit we will read and enjoy many Ancient Greek myths.

### Poetry –

Using high quality descriptive language to capture the mood and atmosphere of Olympic events

### Important Information Year 6 is a very busy year that will absolutely fly by!

**Reading** - It is essential that you read regularly with your child at home. Encourage them to explain answers by using evidence from the text.

**Spelling** – Please help your child to learn their focus spelling rules and the spelling words for their Spelling Bee.

**Times Tables**- Please help your child to be confident in all of their times tables facts. It is important that they can recall these multiplication and division facts rapidly.

**PE days** – **Tuesday and Thursday** – please ensure PE kit is in school every day and is suitable for the weather!

## ENGLISH

**Vocabulary, Grammar, Punctuation (VGP):** We will investigate different word types, sentence types and begin learning where and when to use complex punctuation.

**FOCUS SPELLING RULES:** In Y6 we spend a week recapping spelling rules from across Key Stage 2. During this term we will look at word roots and plurals.

**LIBRARY DAY:** Our library day is early on Tuesday morning but we will also have the flexibility to change books when required.

## R.E.

**God Talk** – consider different ideas that people hold about God, and discuss the different imagery and symbolism used.

**Interpretation** - considering two birth narratives associated with Christmas.

## P.E.

**Real PE** – learning fundamental sports skills and applying them to small sided games.

**Dance** – linked to our Ancient Greek project, we will plan, practise and perform a Greek dance.

## MUSIC

Music will be led by a member of staff from Hampshire Music Service and will focus on linking basic musical skills to our projects.

## MATHEMATICS

### Mental Recall

Identify common factors, common multiples and prime numbers  
Perform mental calculations, including with mixed operations and large numbers

### Multiplication and Division

Written methods for multiplication and division (including short and long multiplication, and short division)  
Remainders – when to round up, and when to round down – using the question to decide!  
Reviewing the idea that multiplication and division are inverse operations

### Measures

Area & volume (using a formula)  
Scaling up/ down (Linking to doubling & fractions)  
Ratio - Currency conversion and metric to imperial conversion

**Cache Cache Cochon** - A revision of counting to 100, and developing the vocabulary of position and rooms of the house.
