Children will also write stories and record information about the Royal Family.

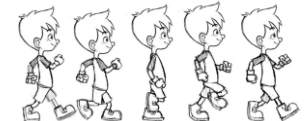


P.E. (gymnastics)

Children will create the own short moving picture and film clip using animation.



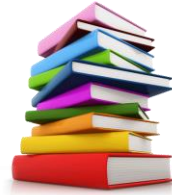
ENGLISH
