IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Reading - It is essential that you continue to encourage your child to read regularly at home. Even better if you can read with them and ask them questions about what they have read.

Spelling - Please help your child to learn their focus spelling rules and the spelling words for their Spelling Bee.

Times Tables- Please help your child to learn their times tables facts. It is important that they can recall facts rapidly.

MATHEMATICS

- Escape - solve puzzles to escape! Each puzzle will link to a different area of maths.
